Dear Parents of 2018 Graduates,

District 211 is providing your senior the opportunity to purchase their currently possessed school-assigned iPad Air at a purchase price of \$130.00. The purchase price includes the currently assigned iPad, cable, charging block, and case. Lost/damaged cases or accessories will not be replaced.

Purchases must be made by May 1, 2018, and payments can be made through the parent portal and/or directed to the school's cashier. No purchases will be allowed after **May 1, 2018**. All outstanding school obligations must be met before the iPad purchase can be made.

Subsequent to the purchase of the iPad, all District-bought apps and licenses will be staged for return to District ownership. These apps and licenses will be removed from the iPad on May 16, 2018. Information regarding how to back up the iPad will be provided. Upon the student's graduation, District 211 relinquishes all responsibility for the purchased iPad and its accessories. Additionally, D211 iPad insurance coverage and technological support for the device ends.

All graduates who choose not purchase their iPad will be required to turn in the device and all accessories at the iPad collection on May 16, 2018, for inspection of the iPad's physical status, cable, charging block, and case. Student iPads are not covered under the District 211 iPad Protection Plan will be assessed replacement cost as described below.
